Below is information regarding our ballet and contemporary dance classes at Discovery Programs. Students in the 2s ballet class attend with their parent/caregiver. All classes age 3 and older are drop-off.

Required Dance Attire:

Pre-Ballet Classes - ages 2, 3/4, 4/5

Pink short sleeve, scoop neck leotard (<u>no skirt attached</u>)
Pink or skin tone tights, pink or skin tone ballet slippers
Or black leggings/pants, white t-shirt, and black/skin tone ballet shoes

Pre-Ballet Classes - ages 5/6, 6/7

Powder blue short sleeve, scoop-neck leotard (<u>no skirt attached</u>)
Pink or skin tone tights, pink or skin tone ballet slippers
Or black leggings/pants, white t-shirt, and black/skin tone ballet shoes

Ballet Classes - ages 7/8, 7.5-9, 9-11

Black short sleeve scoop-neck leotard (<u>no skirt attached</u>)
Pink or skin tone tights, pink or skin tone ballet slippers
Or black leggings/pants, white t-shirt, and black/skin tone ballet shoes

Ballet Classes - ages 12-14

Maroon or burgundy leotard any style (<u>no skirt attached</u>)
Pink or skin tone tights, pink or skin tone ballet slippers
Or black leggings/pants, white t-shirt, and black/skin tone ballet shoes

Contemporary Dance (all ages)

Pink or skin tone footless tights
Any color/style of leotard (no skirt attached)
Or black leggings/pants, white t-shirt, and black/skin tone ballet shoes

Hip Hop (all ages)

Sneakers and comfortable clothing No skirts, dresses, or jeans

No tutus, skirts, or leotards with attached skirts are allowed

Tutus and skirts are permitted in class only on the final day. On these days, children may wear a costume or skirt from home or borrow one.

Hair

If hair is long, it should be pulled back in a ponytail or bun. If hair is short it should be pinned away from the face as well. No jewelry is allowed except for small stud earrings.

Shoes

Ballet slippers should fit like gloves — snug, but in no way cramping toes or restricting movement. Be sure they are wide enough. After your child's teacher checks them for fit, put your child's name in both shoes. Please cut the ballet strings no longer than 2 inches and tie them and/or tuck them in the shoes.
